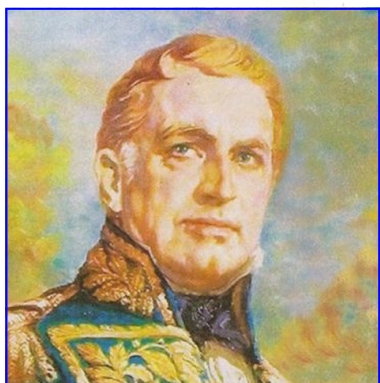

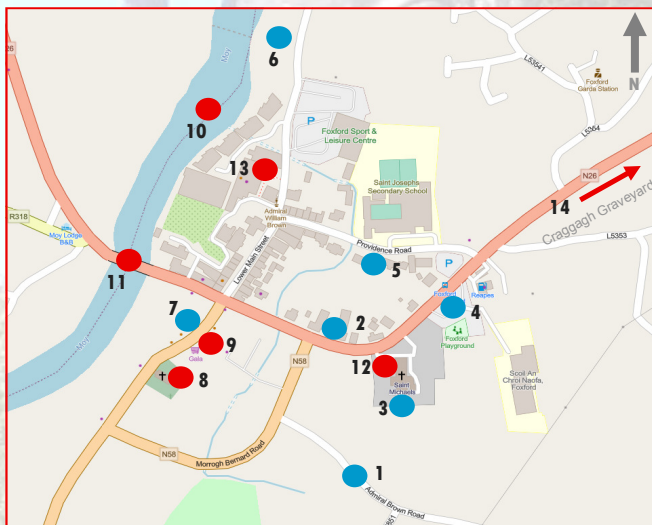

ADMIRAL WILLIAM BROWN

- Founder of Argentine Navy Liberator of South America
- Born Foxford 1777, died Buenos Aires 1857
- Emigrated to Philadelphia, U.S.A. aged 9.
- Became a seaman in the American Merchant Navy.
- Impressed into British Navy.
- Captured twice by French and escaped both times.
- Married Elizabeth Chitty in England 1809.
- Set sail to South America where he was active in maritime trading.
- Founded and led the Argentine Navy.
- Fought in the War of Independence on the Atlantic and Pacific oceans.
- His success at sea led to the liberation of South America
- Founding Father of Argentine Nation.
